## Massey Knakai sells nursery school

In an all cash transaction valued at approximately \$625,000, the property at 249 East 30th Street has been sold, according to Robert A. Knakal, president of Massey Knakal Realty Services.

The property, located on the north side of East 30th Street between Second and Third Avenues, is a 23-foot wide building which was previously the home of the Bethlehem Day School. The property contains a total of 9,600 square feet on its five stories, has an elevator and was delivered vacant and in need of renovation at the time of sale. The property was purchased by investor Charles Fridman, while plans on renovating the property into a multi-unit apartment house.

"This sale substantiates the excellent interest and demand there has been on the block during the past year," said John Ciriquio, vice president of Massey Knakal, who handled the marketing of the property for the day sense it.
